Introduction

Security+ is a company-neutral, industry-wide recognition of network security skills. This course is designed for students who wish to acquire the knowledge specific skills required to implement basic security services on any type of computer network.

Prerequisites

Before attending this course, it is advisable that students have the CompTIA A+ and Network+ certifications, or equivalent knowledge, and six to nine months experience in networking, including experience configuring and managing TCP/IP. Students who do not meet these criteria can attend the IN-AA and IN-NN courses.

- Harden internal systems and services.
- Harden internetwork devices and services.
- Secure network communications.
- Manage a PKI.
- Manage certificates.
